In response to a number of requests, the format of the Conference agenda has been reviewed by the Executive Board, and a decision has been made to re-structure the items in such a way as to encourage greater participation and interaction throughout the proceedings. In particular, we hope that the Air Sports Forum and the Technical Forum, as well as the proposed resolutions on Airspace and Language Proficiency Requirements will provide material for lively debate.

Timings for agenda items are suggested in an attempt to ensure that ample time is available for the most important issues. Needless to say, these timings may need to be adjusted in the light of experience and requests from Conference delegates. They should not be viewed as an attempt to stifle legitimate debate, but rather to encourage lively exchanges.


This year, there are many elections which will inevitably take some time to conduct. Every effort is however being made to shorten the time taken.
